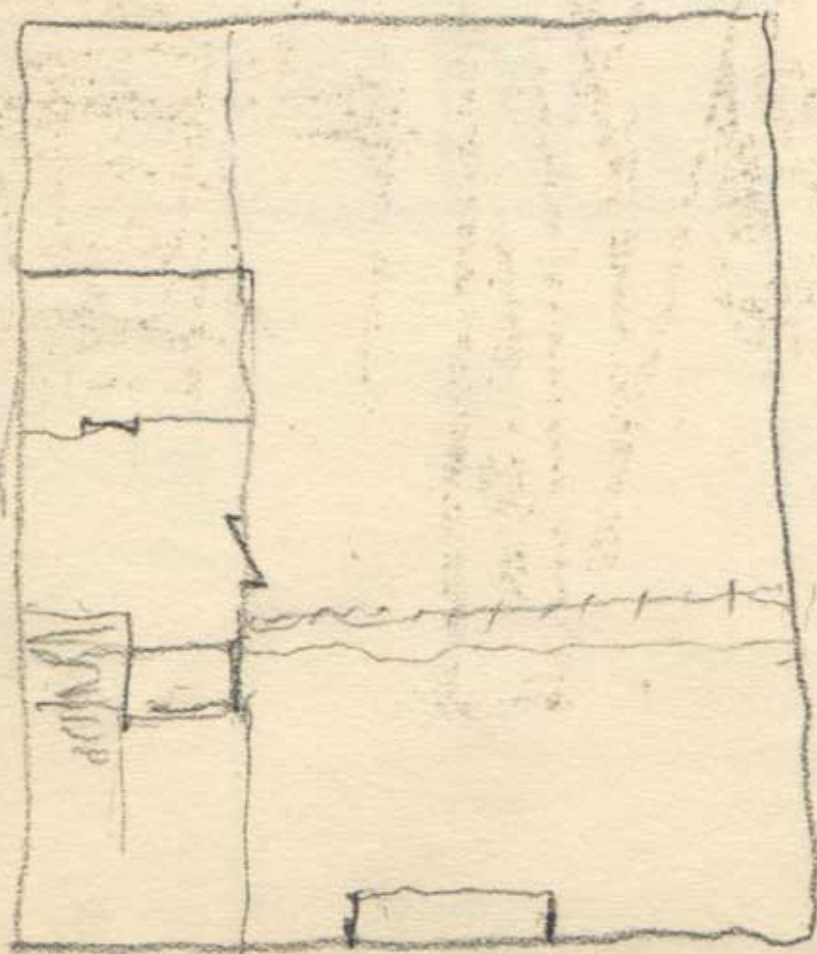


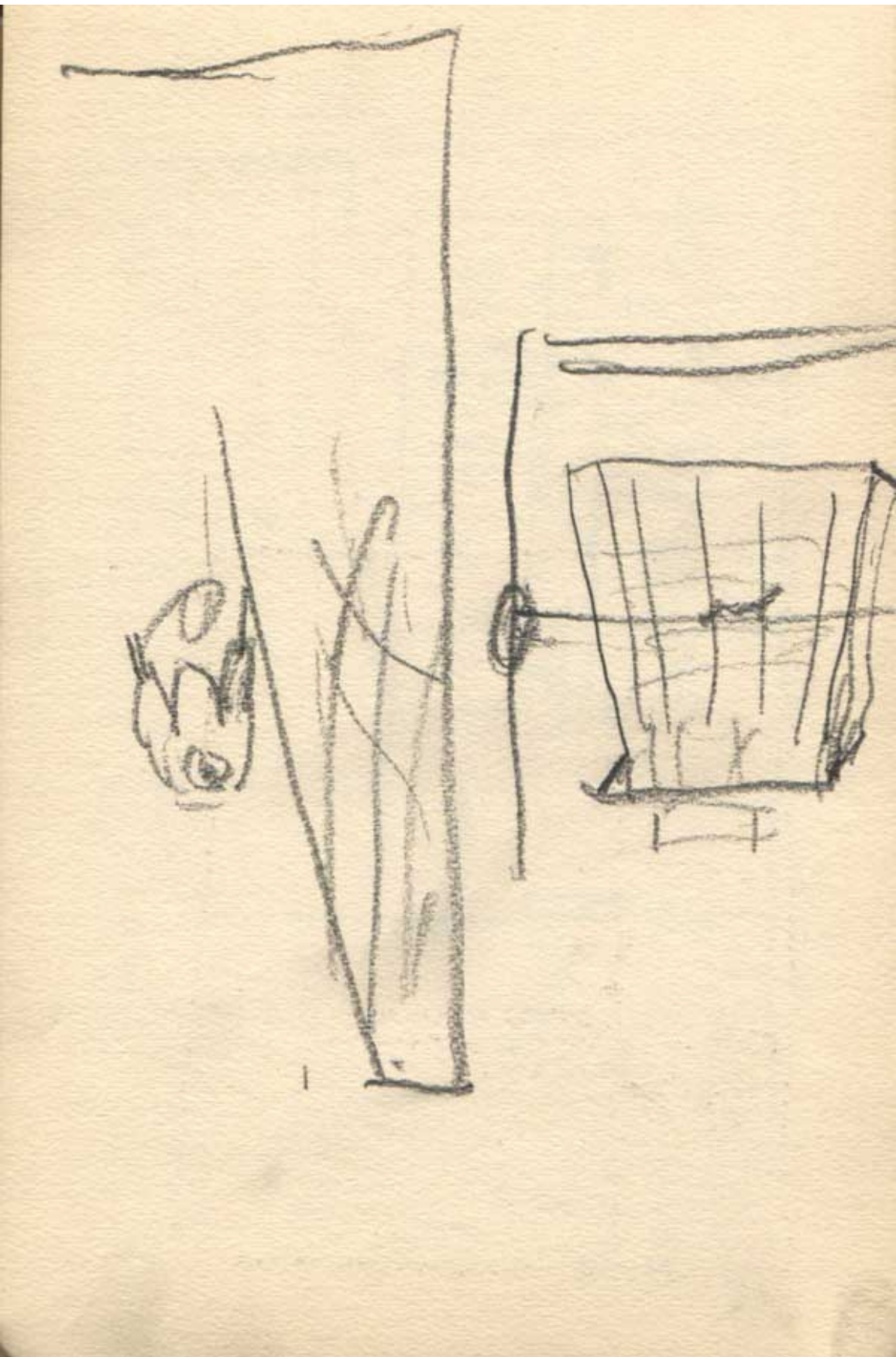


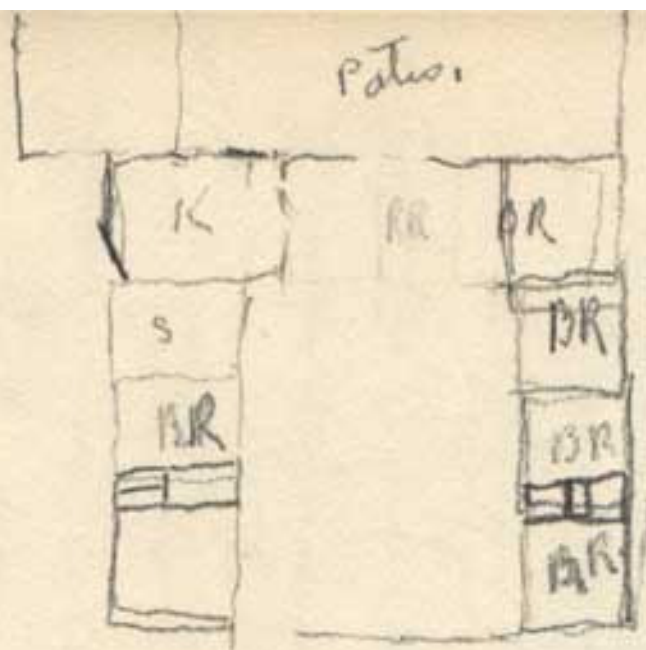


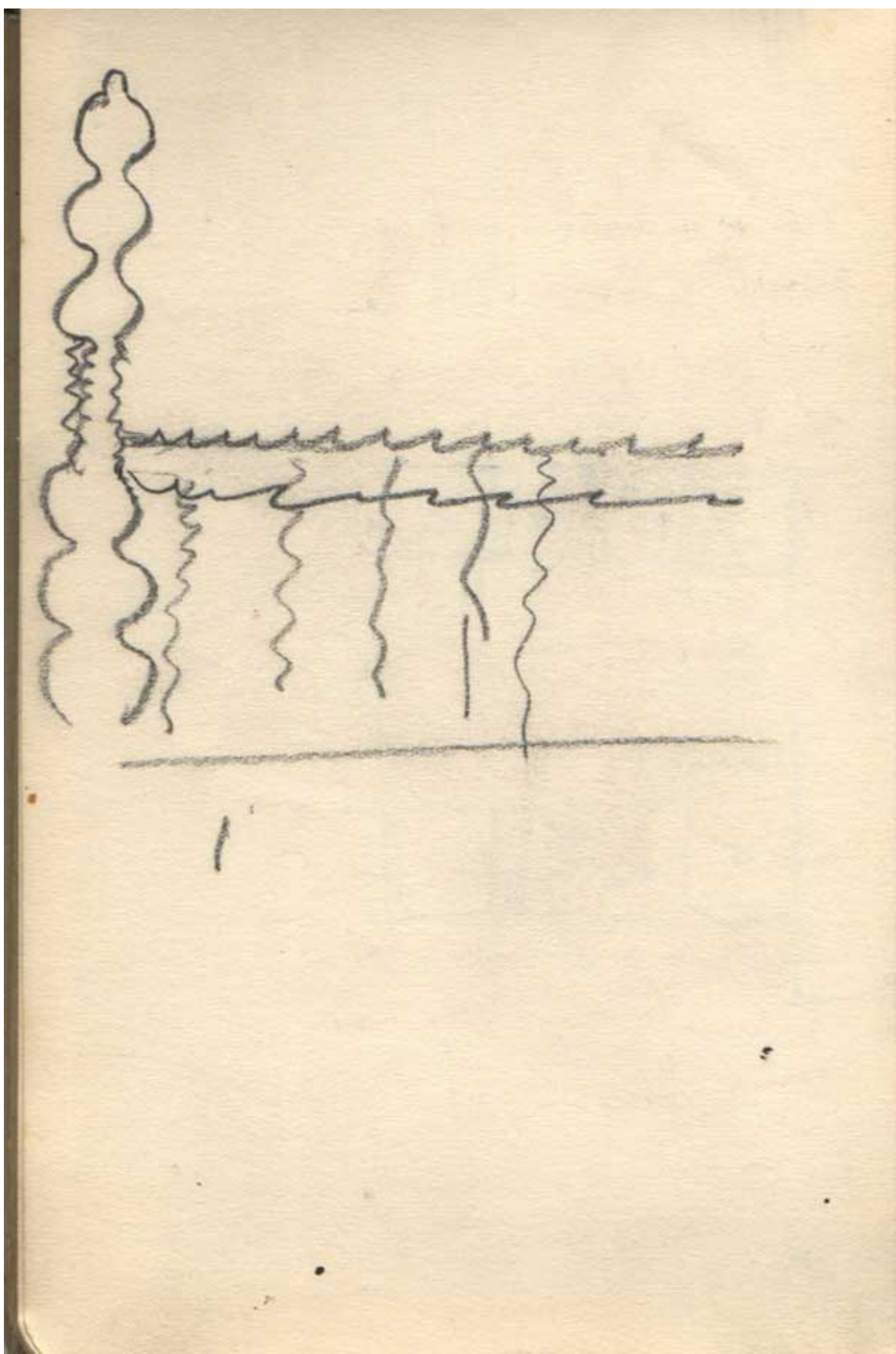












Pontiac June 4/31
